





- Ski hand-out before Semi-finals and Finals in Zone 3







No-coaching zone in the stadium





## Stadium 7/1

- March-in 5 minutes before start
- No coaches in the start area
- Plow start with electric gun shot
- 40 meters no-skating zone from the start
- 4 corridors in the finish
- No coaches in the finish area
- Ski hand-in for fluor testing in Zone 4 after finish
- Ski hand-out after fluor testing in Zone 5






### Course 7/1 – Senior and Para standing

Senior Men, Women, Para Standing: <mark>3</mark> x 5 km black Para Standing junior: <mark>2</mark> x 5 km black

- Organiser will have neutral pole service 100 m after the start and a feed zone in the stadium
- No-coaching zones
- No-coaching zone in the stadium
- Recommended coaching zones marked on the map
- TV production from ATV in parts of the course
- Coaches must act careful in the ATV zone and give way to the ATV

Courses and ski test area will be groomed between 21:00 and 23:59 6/1






## Course 7/1 – Para Sit

Course: 3 x 1,5 km

1 track - on skiers right

No-coaching zone in the stadium

Courses and ski test area will be groomed between 21:00 and 23:59 6/1








### Ski testing, warm-up and training

- Competition courses can be used when they are open for training. <u>Only ski in course</u> <u>direction.</u>
- Ski test area next to the service area, south of the stadium. Follow sign-posting.
- The ski test area will be groomed in the same way at the same time as the competition courses.
- Warm-up can be done in the ski test area and other tracks, south of the ski test area.
- On Saturday, during the sprint competition, the rest of the competition tracks outside the sprint course can be used for training.





## **Fluor testing**

- All skis must be marked with start number, name and club before the start.
- Stickers for ski marking can be picked up at the race office. The sticker should be placed on warm skis, and behind the binding.
- After finish the skis shall be placed in Zone 4 for fluor control.
- After the fluor test is done the skis can be picked up in Zone 5.


#### **Sprint Qualification**

 All skis shall be placed in Zone 4 after qualification and picked up in Zone 5 – as other competition formats

#### **Sprint Finals**

- All skis shall be placed in Zone 4 after each heat/final.
- Competitors qualifying for Semi-finals and Finals can pick up the skis in Zone 3 in the start area before their next heat.
- No waxing/treatment/adjustment to the skies between the finals are allowed.
- After the Final and for competitors not qualifying for Semi-finals or Finals, the skis can be picked up in Zone 5 after the fluor test is done.









### **Start Number**

- Starting bibs can be picked up by the competitors at the race office.
- Two transponders will be used during the races 1 personal and 1 from the organiser. The organiser's transponder is picked up at the race office together with starting bib.
- Transponder check is possible at the race office.
- Starting bibs and the organiser's transponder shall be returned after each competition in the finish area.
- In Saturday's sprint, the same starting bibs will be used in the qualification and finals. Leg number bibs can be picked up from the race office before the Finals.
- Anyone who do not finish the race MUST notify the race office.
- Destroyed or lost starting bibs will be invoiced the competitors club 800 NOK





### **Prize Giving**

- Top 6 in each class each day will be awarded as soon as possible after finish.
- Participant prizes to <u>ALL</u> competitiors can be picked up at the race office.
- Prize giving seremonies: No skis or other equipments during the prize giving ceremony. (ICR 207.1.1)





### **Doping Control**

Doping control may be conducted, following NIF and Antidoping Norge rules.





### Parking

Parking at designated areas the Lygna Skisenter.

Parking fee 100 NOK per day or 200 NOK for both days. Payment to Vipps **84258**, or cash at the race office for foreign participants.





### **General information from Organiser**

- Fair Play Respect the training times before the competition.
- Only training in track direction
- No-coaching zones are signposted along the course see course map. The signs along the track marks the zone.





### **General information from TD**

- Team leaders shall follow the Organiser's instructions (ICR 344.1)
- Competitors shall not obstruct other competitors (ICR 343.9)
- Overlapping rule (ICR 343.14) will not apply in Sunday's competitions
- Fluor testing after finish
