3 Official training

The tracks for all days will be marked not later than the day before each race for inspecting the course. Note that the tracks are still open to the public and there will be traffic on the roads, normal traffic rules apply.

For Friday race in free technique the track will be prepared and closed off 11:30-13:20. For Sunday race in classic technique the track will be prepared and closed off 10:30-11:10.

For Saturday and Sunday races the course are marked in advance and can be tested while it is opened to the public. There will also be LOC representatives guiding the tracks on a couple of occasions prior the race, contact LOC in case of interest.

For roller ski training there is also an roller-ski track at the local ski club TSOK close to the 15km track area.

4 Rollerski equipment

LOC will provide loan skis from SWENOR for the athletes, skate for Friday with wheel type 2 and classic skis with wheel type 3 on Saturday and Sunday. Details for where and when to get the skis are described in the PM and through the TCM.

Poles must be of approved length and type. Note the rule for 30mm diameter ferrules.

Helmet and goggles are mandatory. If rain goggles are optional after information from the jury.

Friday:



Swenor Skate Long is a directionally stable and lightweight roller ski with a submerged aluminum frame. Wheels #2.

Saturday and Sunday:



Swenor Alutech, the low weight and rigid construction result in an easy-tohandle and stable roller ski appreciated by many. Wheels #3.







5 Entries

Swedish athletes make their own entries directly in SSF TA. For all other nations the entry form must be filled in and sent to LOC at <u>fredrik@alliansloppet.se</u>. The LOC will add all participants into SSF TA where the official and updated list will be held.

LOC will need a preliminary list of participants not later than July 3rd. Participants registered but does not start are asked to inform the organizer that they will not participate as soon as possible (at the latest at the team captain meeting). There will be no registration fee for World Cup athletes.

Only competitors with an active FIS Code and entered by the LOC are allowed to participate in FIS Roller Ski World Cup. For any other information about entries, please refer to the <u>Rules for the FIS Roller Ski World Cup / World Championships</u>.

6 Accommodation

Teams/athletes will be accommodated in hotels of a good standard in the village of Trollhättan and close by Vänersborg.

Deadline for bookings

Within the 3rd of July 2025 the quantity of double and single rooms as well as arrival/departure days must be communicated to the LOC. Please note that after this date the LOC is not able to guarantee the availability of the rooms at event-prices.

As soon as the LOC receives the requests, a detailed offer will be sent to the NSA.

Payment

Teams will be invoiced from the LOC after the competition. The NSA must provide invoice information upon registration.

Cancellation Fee

Until 30 days before the first competition teams can change their bookings by adapting the preliminary entry.

Cancellation (entire team or only some rooms) after 30 days before the first competition leads to full payment for the accommodation.







7 Transportation

Teams travelling by plane have the possibility to get free transportation from/to the competition venue, according to the following conditions:

- the LOC can offer only one free of charge transfer per team from the official airport to the venue and one from the venue to the airport
- the departure and arrival times must be communicated to the organiser latest one month before the first competition
- the official airport is Landvetter Airport in Gothenburg, Sweden.

8 Insurance

All participants must have an insurance coverage. The LOC is not liable for any kind of accidents, injury, damages, or lost property.

9 Accreditation

There will be no specific accreditation needed.
