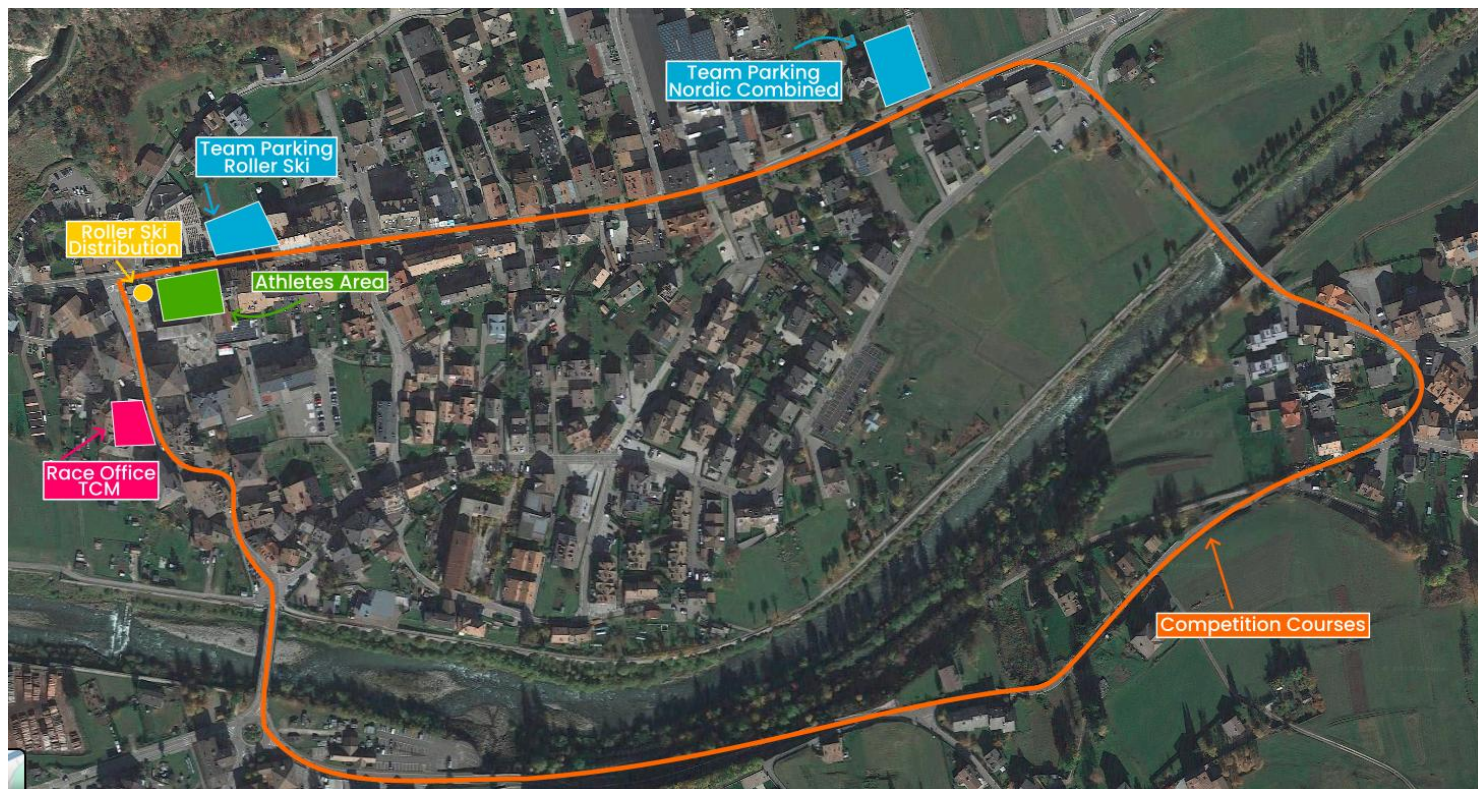

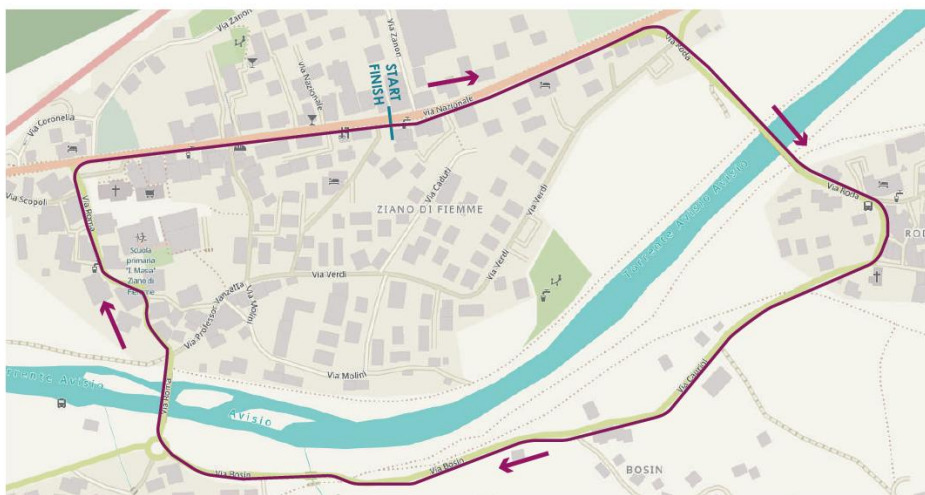

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5 Entries

The entries must be sent via **FIS on-line system** by the respective National Ski Associations, within the deadlines set by FIS.

- *42 days before the first competition (7th August 2025 for Ski Jumping and Nordic Combined; 8th August 2025 for Roller Ski):* deadline for sending preliminary entries and accommodation requests
- *8 days before the first competition (10th September 2025 for Ski Jumping and Nordic Combined; 11th September 2025 for Roller Ski):* deadline for sending entries

Only competitors with an **active FIS Code** and entered by the NSA are allowed to participate in FIS Roller Ski World Cup.

6 Race Office

6.1 Main Race Office

The Race Office is located at the Ski Jumping Stadium in Predazzo and will be open at the following times:

- **Wednesday:** 14:00 – 18:00
- **Thursday:** 08:00 – 23:00
- **Friday:** 08:00 – 12:00 / 14:00 – 21:30
- **Saturday:** 08:00 – 12:00 / 14:00 – 22:45

6.2 Sub Race Office

7 Teams Captains Meeting

7.1 Ski Jumping

The TCM (Team Captains' Meeting) room at the Ski Jumping Stadium is located on the ground floor of the main building, next to the Race Office.

7.2 Nordic Combined

The TCM (Team Captains' Meeting) room at the Ski Jumping Stadium is located on the ground floor of the main building, next to the Race Office.

7.3 Roller Ski

The TCM (Team Captains' Meeting) room for the Roller Ski competitions is in Ziano di Fiemme, on the first floor of the "Tabià del Moco", above the Cassa Rurale di Fiemme bank, at Piazza IV Novembre, 4.

8 Bibs

8.1 Ski Jumping

The bibs distribution will take place in the Sport Info Desk, on the ground floor of the Wooden Hut.

8.2 Nordic Combined

The bibs distribution will take place in the Sport Info Desk, on the ground floor of the Wooden Hut. For Roller Ski competitions, bib distribution will be carried out directly at the start area.

8.3 Roller Ski

The bibs for each competition will be delivered directly in the start area.

9 Equipment for Roller Ski Competition (not Nordic Combined)

The distribution of roller skis will take place in the athletes' area located at the start zone.

For the Team Mix Sprint competition in free technique of Saturday 20th September, LOC will provide skating roller skis. For the Mass Start competition in free technique of Sunday 21st September, LOC will provide free roller skis.

Official provider: [FF Skis - Norway](#). Please refer to the company for any further information regarding the provided rollerski.

- All roller skis will be marked. Athletes or teams are not allowed to make any adjustments of skis or wheels including lubrication. In all the competition the distribution of roller skis will be done 15 minutes before the start of each category (see details on the official program, article 3). At the end of the race, roller skis must be returned.
- For the Individual sprint competition, teams have to use their own skating roller ski, with free wheels. The roller ski of the teams must be in compliance with FIS rules:
 - roller skis have to be commercially available.
 - the distance between roller ski axles cannot be less than 530 mm
 - the wheel diameter cannot be more than 100 mm
 - ski boots must be attached to roller skis using ski bindings

10 Wax Cabins

The wax cabins will be allocated according to the FIS quota regulations and distributed based on availability.

The preliminary entries are also valid as deadline for the reservation of additional waxing cabins; late reservation will not be taken into consideration. The deadline is on 07.08.2025.

Available from Wednesday, September 17th, 2025.

For entering the Team Area every person must exhibit the accreditation.

You can get the keys of the cabins at the Race Office.

11 Transportation

11.1 Shuttle

Teams travelling by plane have the possibility to get free transportation from/to the competition venue, according to the following conditions:

- the LOC can offer only one free of charge transfer per team from the official airport to the venue and one from the venue to the airport
- The **deadline** for reserving the transport from the airport to Val di Fiemme and from Val di Fiemme to the airport is 05.09.2025
- the official airports are VERONA, VENEZIA and MUNICH.

We will try to accommodate the teams mostly in Ziano di Fiemme, in order to allow the participants to reach the competition site by foot.

No shuttle service in the valley will be organised by the OC.

11.2 How to reach Val di Fiemme

Val di Fiemme is located in the Trentino region of northern Italy, in the heart of the Dolomites. Here are the main ways to reach the valley:

- **By plane:**

The nearest airports are:

- Verona (VRN) – 160 km
- Innsbruck (INN) – 170 km
- Venice (VCE) – 190 km
- Milan Bergamo (BGY) – 250 km
-

- **By train:**

The closest major train station is Trento. From Trento, regular bus connections (Trentino Trasporti) are available to Cavalese, Predazzo, and other towns in Val di Fiemme.

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- **Coming by car:**

- From **north**: Austria - Brenner Pass - Bolzano - Val di Fiemme
- From **east**: Slovenia - Trieste - Belluno - Val di Fiemme
- From **south**: Venezia - Verona - Trento - Val di Fiemme
- From **west**: Milano - Verona - Trento - Val di Fiemme

13 Accreditation

The accreditations for teams/staff/technicians/officials/coaches/SRS will be prepared importing all the data from the entries made through the **FIS online system**, so **no accreditation request will be necessary for all the people that sent the online FIS registration**.

People that need LOC Accreditation will have to pick it up at the accreditation office on the following days:

- **Wednesday:** 14:00 – 18:00
- **Thursday:** 08:00 – 12:00 / 14:00 – 21:00
- **Friday:** 08:00 – 12:00 / 15:00 – 21:00
- **Saturday:** 08:00 – 12:00 / 16:00 – 21:00
- **Sunday:** 08:00 – 14:00

Teams/staff/technicians/officials/coaches/SRS will need the accreditation to enter the Team Area. Together with teams' accreditation you will also get the Team parking pass that you need, but please consider that season parking passes are valid too.
